TIPS FOR BUSINESSES TO HELP GET OUT THE VOTE

- Email and post reminders and links to the above resources
- Allow time in the workday for employees to go vote (not just on Election Day)
- Share voting [guides](#) to help employees understand what's on the ballot

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

- **Primary Election Day is Tuesday, May 24.**
- Did you know that in a primary election you can choose one party's ballot even if you're unaffiliated or affiliated with another party? You're empowered to make a difference! Still, only 15% of eligible Arkansans vote in the primaries.
- The deadline for registering by mail to vote is (postmarked by) **April 25**. The deadline to register in-person to vote is **April 25**.
- The deadline to request a ballot by mail is (received by) **May 17**. To drop it off in person, the deadline is **May 20**.
- The early voting period runs from **May 9 to May 23**.

DON'T FORGET!

In person voters must bring a photo ID issued by the state or federal government.
